This funding will be used to

- Support 90% of students to attain an A-C in English, Mathematics, Science and HASS.
- Support a minimum of 15% of students to attain an A in English, Mathematics, Science and HASS.
- Improve teacher capacity in delivering the Foxwell SSC Quality Teaching and Learning Framework.
- Support student attainment in NAPLAN testing with a minimum of 95% of students achieving at or above the 2022 National Minimum Standards in Reading, Writing and Numeracy.
- Support student attainment at the Upper 3 Bands in Reading, Writing and Numeracy.
- Target support for students with additional needs to fully access the curriculum.
- Further enhance student leadership capability and the building of a strong school culture.
- Support the mental health and wellbeing of students.

Our initiatives include

- Providing professional learning, mentoring, coaching, and observations processes across the College to fully embed the Foxwell SSC Quality Teaching and Learning Framework.
- Implementing a range of initiatives within the Learning and Wellbeing Framework to support student outcomes, engagement, mental health and wellbeing. Positive Education and State the improvement initiatives.
- Providing students access to What I Need (WIN) time to support their literacy and numeracy development.
- Providing targeted extension or intervention programs for students to achieve improved literacy and numeracy outcomes.
